64.50 Stream 2 lks. wide, flows W. 200 ft. below  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor.;  
thence over nearly level ground.

80.07 Set a yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the  
ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, marked  
T 27 S S 25 on NE., R 8 W S 36 on SE., S 35 on SW.,  
and S 26 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on S. and E.  
edges, from which

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.26\*E., 56 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 8 W S 25 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.20\*E., 68 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 8 W S 36 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.56\*30'W., 65 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 8 W S 35 B T.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N.35\*W., 120 lks. dist.,  
marked T 27 S R 8 W S 26 B T.
