40.00 Set fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., Set in stone mound 3 ft. base 1½ ft. high; on point of rocky ridge, 100 ft. below summit, for ¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ S on N. face; from which

A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears N.78\*W., 62 lks. dist., marked ¼ S B T.

65.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, flows W.
