55.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, flows E.

59.40 Branch, 4 lks. wide, flows SE.

80.00 Set a cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, marked T 27 S S 13 on NE., R 8 W S 24 on SE., S 23 on SW., and S 14 on NW. faces, with 3 notches on S. and 1
