80.06 Intersect N. and S. line, 12 lks. S. of cor. to secs. 14,
15, 22 and 23. Thence I run

S.89*43'W. on a true line bet. secs. 15 and 22.

Ascend from cor. 25 ft. to

25.00 To top of ridge, bears N. and descend on S. slope of ridge.

30.00 Dry gulch, course SE.

40.03 Set fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on N. face; from

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.82*W., 59 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

76.50 Branch, 1 lk. wide, flows SW.

80.06 The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, scattering fir, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, Madrone, mountain myrtle, arrow-wood and
willow.

Mountainous land, or land covered with dense under-
