18.25 Small branch, flows W.

40.00 Set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W. face; from whichA fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.32*E., 36 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.35*W., 38 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.

43.00 Top of yew ridge, 500 ft. above sec cor. bears NW. and SE. and descend 150 ft. to

55.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, flows NW.

80.00 Set yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, marked T 27 S S 10 on NE., R 8 W S 15 on SE., S 16 on SW., and S 9 on NW. faces, with 4 notches on S. and 3 notches on E. edges; from which

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.15*E., 46 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 10 B T.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.47*E., 65 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 15 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.33*W., 80 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 16 B T.

A hemlock, 7 ins. diam., bears N.67*W., 11 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 9 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and cedar.

Undergrowth, laurel, vinemaple, briars and salal.

Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
