	Aug 21, 1896.
	N.89°43'E. on a random line bet. secs. 10 and 15.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.20	Intersect N. and S. line, 17 lks. N. of cor. to secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, thence I run S.89°50'W. on a true line bet. secs. 10 and 15.
	Descend from cor, over uneyen ground, on N. slope of ridge.
11.00	Branch, 2 lks. wide, flows NW.
40.10	Set a yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face; from which A fir, 3 ins. diam., bears S.65°E., 42 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears N.43°W., 61 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
60.00	Branch, 4 lks. wide, course NW. 300 ft. below sec. cor. Ascend 150 ft. to
75.25	Top of spur, bears N.20°W.
77.30	Small branch, flows N. 150 ft. below spur, and ascend 100 ft. to
80.20	The cor. to secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, 100 ft. above creek. Land, mountainous. Soil, 4th rate. Thickly timbered with small fir, hemlock and cedar. Undergrowth, laurel, vinemaple, salal and briars. Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.20 chs.
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	N.0°2'W. bet secs. 9 and 10. Descend from cor.
3.50	Branch, 3 lks. wide, flows W.
15.00	Five Mile Creek, 20 lks. wide, flows W. 200 ft. below cor. and ascend steep rocky bluff.
