

Subdivisions of T. 27 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

- 25.00 Summit of bluff, 250 ft. above creek, bears E. and W.
- 40.00 Set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W. face; from which
- A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.42*E., 72 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.80*30*W., 48 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
- 43.00 Branch, 2 lks. wide, flows SW.
- 67.00 Leave live timber and enter old burn, 500 ft. above Five Mile Creek, bears E. and W. thence over nearly level ground.
- 80.00 Set yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, marked T 27 S S 3 on NE., R 8 W S 10 on SE., S 9 on SW., and S 4 on NW. faces, with 5 notches on S. and 3 notches on E. edges; from which
- A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.76*E., 77 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 3 B T.
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.27*E., 72 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 10 B T.
- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 82 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 9 B T.
- A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.58*W., 109 lks. dist., marked T 27 S R 8 W S 4 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and cedar; dead and fallen for the last 13 chs.

Undergrowth, laurel, vinemaple, yew and briars.

Mountainous land, or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
