CHAINS	
	Thence I run S.0*3'E., on true line bet. secs. 4 and 5. Va. 20*15'E. Ascend from cor.
1.50	Summit of ridge, 50 ft. above cor. bears NE. and SW.
13.00	Descend gradually
25.00	Branch 3 lks. wide, course SE
28.50	Branch 2 lks. wide, course SE.
31.00	Descend steep slope
39.97	Set a yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W. face, from which A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 55 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.41*E., 75 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T
68.50	Panther Creek, 25 lks. wide, course SW. 650 ft. below summit; and descend.
79.97	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, 150 ft. above creek bank Land, mountainous Soil, 4th rate Timber, fir, hemlock and cedar, nearly all dead and fallen Undergrowth, maple, willow, fir and hemlock Mountainous land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 79.91 chs.
	From the established cor. of secs. 31 and 32 on the South bdy. of Tp. which is a post firmly set marked and witnessed as heretofore described I run N.0*4'W. bet. secs. 31 and 32. Ascend from cor.
6.50	A fir, 48 ins. in diam., on line, I mark with 2 notches on North and South sides.
