40.00	<p>East on a random line bet. secs. 29 and 32. Set temp. <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor.</p>
80.24	<p>Intersect N. and S. line 15 lks. S. of the cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33. Thence I run S.89°54'W. on a true line bet. secs. 29 and 32. Descend from cor.</p>
8.50	<p>Branch 2 lks. wide course SW.; thence ascend</p>
20.00	<p>Summit of spur 100 ft. above branch bears NE. and SW. Descend</p>
40.12	<p>Set a yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S. on N. face, from which A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N.38°W., 9 lks. dist. Marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S B T A cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears S.18°30'W., 14 lks. dist. Marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S B T</p>
