	Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple and salal Mountainous land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.06 chs.
40.00	S.89°55'W. on a random line bet. secs. 19 and 30. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
79.94	Intersect West bdy. of Tp, 16 lks. North of cor. to secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, heretofore described Thence I run N.89°48'E. on a true line bet. secs. 19 and 30. Descend from cor. on South slope of ridge.
35.00	Branch 2 lks. wide, course SE; thence ascend
39.94	Set a yew post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on N. face, from which A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears S.42°E., 75 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 90 lks. dist. Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T
45.50	Summit of ridge, 80 ft. above creek, bears SE. and NW.; descend
54.75	Branch 2 lks. wide, course SE, 100 ft. below summit; ascend
61.00	Small branch, course SE.
79.94	The cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30 Land, mountainous Soil, 3rd rate Heavily timbered with fir, hemlock and cedar Undergrowth, laurel, vine maple and salal and fern. Mountainous land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 79.94 chs.
