A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.55*E., 17 lks. dist., marked T. 28 S R 1 W S 36 B T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.81*W., 34 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 1 W S 35 B T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.79*W., 49 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 1 W S 26 B T.
