CHAINS	<p>Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, cedar, and laurel. Undergrowth, laurel and vine maple. Mountainous, or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.</p>
40.00	<p>East, on a random line, bet. secs. 26 and 35. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
80.20	<p>Intersect N. and S. line at the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36. Thence I run. West, on a true line, bet. secs. 26 and 35. Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
40.10	<p>Set a basalt stone, 15x12x4 ins., 10 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; from which, A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.50°E., 73 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 B T. A fir, 60 ins. diam., bears SW. 12 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 B T.</p>
44.00	<p>Begin ascent, bears SE. and NW.</p>
77.90	<p>A spring branch 10 lks. wide, course SE. Ascend.</p>
80.20	<p>The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35. Land, mountainous. Soil, 4th. rate. Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, cedar and laurel, and oak. Undergrowth, laurel, willow and huckleberry. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with undergrowth. 80.20 chs.</p>
4.50	<p>N.0°2'W. bet. secs. 26 and 27 . Along side of mountain bears SE. and NW. through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. A creek 10 lks. wide, course S.10°E.</p>
6.50	<p>Begins ascent, bears, SE. and NW.</p>
