Subdivisions of T. 28 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

with dense undergrowth. 79.70 chs.

N.0*2'W., bet. secs. 27 and 28.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 40.00 Set a basalt stone, 20x12x8 ins., 15 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which,
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.66*E., 16 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 27 B T.
- A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.40*W., 9 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 28 B T.

- 44.00 Top of divide, bears SE. and NW.
Descend.

- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 12x8x6 ins., 8 ins. in ground for cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, marked with 2 notches on S. and 3 notches on E. edges; from which,
- A laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears N.78*E., 44 lks. dist., marked T. 28 S R 1 W S 22 B T.
- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.72*E., 34 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 1 W S 27 B T.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.14*W., 67 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 1 W S 28 B T.
- A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.60*W., 19 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 1 W S 21 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony and 4th. rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, laurel, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, laurel and vine maple.

Mountainous, or heavy timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth. 80.00 chs.

S.89*45'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 22 and 27.

- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

- 80.00 Intersect N. and S. line at the cor of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.
