40.05 Set a basalt stone, 15x12x6 ins., 10 ins. in ground for  
¼ sec. cor. marked ¼ on N. face; from which,

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 40 lks. dist.,  
marked ¼ S 9 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.38°E., 23 lks. dist.,  
marked ¼ S 16 B T.
