

## Subdivision of T. 28 S., R. 2 W.

## CHAINS

- 80.04 Cor. secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.  
Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky; 4th rate.  
Timber, cedar, pine and hemlock.  
Underbrush, rhododendrons, vine maple, young firs, greasewood and willows.  
Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey, 80.04 chs.
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- Thence I run  
S.89°59'W., on random line, bet. secs. 19 and 30.
- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 80.03 Intersect 1 lk. N of cor. secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30.  
Thence I run  
N.89°59'E., on true line, bet. secs. 19 and 30.  
Through dense underbrush and heavy timber; descend NW slope.
- 9.08 Creek, 3 lks. wide, flows N.; ascend NW slope.
- 16.00 Top of ridge, bears N and S.; descend E slope.
- 40.03 Set yew post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 19 on N and 30 on S face, from which  
A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S.78°E., 8 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 30 B T.  
A hemlock, 5 ins. diam., bears N.5°E., 17 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 19 B T.
- 43.00 Ravine, bears N.; ascend NW slope.
- 44.00 Top of ridge, bears N and S.; descend NE slope.
- 58.30 Ravine, bears N.; ascend W slope.
- 80.03 Cor. secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.
