CHAINS

Underbrush, rhododendrons, vine maple, greasewood and young firs.
Land; mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily
timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey. 74.41 chs.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

This fractional township is rough and mountainous, and contains very little agricultural land, and only a very few small tracts fit for cultivation. It is covered with heavy growth of timber, which consists principally of yellow pine, cedar, fir and hemlock.

There are two settlers in this fractional township. Mr. Tuttle is located in the northern part of section 19; his improvements consist of house, fences, clearing and cultivated land; approximate value, \$500.

William Robinett, is located in the northern part of section 6; his improvements consist of house, barn, fences, clearing and cultivated land; approximate value, \$600.
