Soil, clay loam, 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock and pine.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin, vine maple and hemlock.

S.89°45'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 13 and 24.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

81.05 Intersect E bdy. of Tp. 35 lks. S of the cor. of secs. 13 and 24.

Thence, West, on a true line, bet. secs. 13 and 24.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Over broken S slope.

8.77 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SE. Ascend NE slope.

31.45 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

41.05 250 feet above sec. cor.; set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

44.60 Divide, between Dumore and Cavitt Creeks, bears NE and SW.; descend 150 feet over NW slope.

50.18 Trail, Deadman to Red Butte, bears NE and SW.

53.76 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course NW.

54.00 Brook, 1 lk. wide, course N.; continue over rolling land.

64.50 Descend 125 feet, over NW slope to
