

Subdivision of T. 28 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

71.30 Spur, slopes NW.; descend gradually.

77.70 The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam; 2d and 3d rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock and pine.

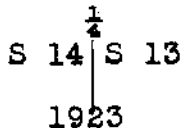
Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin, vine maple and hemlock.

North on a Sectional Guide Meridian bet. secs. 13 and 14.  
Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Descend 280 feet over NE slope to  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

30.05 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course NW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked



from which

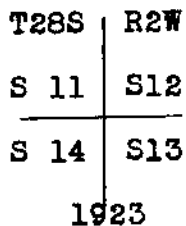
A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.81°E., 16 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 13 B T.

A cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears S.42°W., 30 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 14 B T.

Continue over rolling W slope to

66.37 Brook, 3 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend 180 feet over SW slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears N.41°E., 30 lks.
