7.80	Creek, 6 lks. wide, course NW.
10.53	Same creek, course SW.
20.18	Same creek, course NW.
28.59	Same creek, course SW.
29.55	Creek, 4 lks. wide, course SW.
33.13	Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SW.
