CHAINS

- 53.85 Stream, 5 lks. wide, course NW.
- 61.20 Stream, 4 lks. wide, course SW.
- 65.60 Stream, 2 lks. wide, course NW.
- 80.00 Set Fir post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, marked T 28 S S 16 on NE, R 3 W S 21 on SE, S 20 on SW, and S 17 on NW faces, with 4 notches on E and 3 on S edges, from which
 - A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.40°E., 18 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 3 W S 16 B T.
 - A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.65°E., 38 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 3 W S 21 B T.
 - A Fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.80°W., 31 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 3 W S 20 B T.
 - A Hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears N.10°W., 39 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 3 W S 17 B T.

This mile is rough, crossing ridges and canyons.
Densely covered with forests of Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Laurel.
Thick undergrowth of Vine maple and Huckleberry.

N.89°41'E., on true line bet. secs. 16 and 21. Va. 18°45'E.

- 0.50 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course W.
- 15.00 Bottom of deep ravine.
- 30.00 Commenced to ascend.
- 40.00 Set cedar post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N and S faces, from which
 - A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.55°W., 14 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
 - A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 14 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.
- 42.00 Enter Swamp.
- 45.00 Leave Swamp.
- 75.25 Summit of hill.
