8.90	Morrison and Tuttle trail, bears N. and S.
10.00	Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW., descend N. slope.
23.00	Enter heavy timber, ascend E. slope.
40.01	<p>Set fir stake, 3 ft. long, 6 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S 23 on N., and 26 on S. face, and dig pits 18x18x12 ins., E. and W. of cor., and raise mound of earth, 3-1/2 ft. base, 1-1/2 ft. high N. of cor., from which:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.41°E., 62 lks dist. marked 1/4 S 26 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">No other tree fit to mark.</p> <p>Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend W. slope.</p>

80.02	<p>Cor. secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.</p> <p>Land, mountainous.</p> <p>Soil, rocky; rate 4th.</p> <p>Timber, cedar, fir and matherone.</p> <p>Underbrush, young firs, vine maple and rhododendrons.</p> <p>Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush or heavily timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey.</p>
