

Subdivisions of T.28 S R 3 W.

CHAINS

- At cor. secs. 2 and 3 on N.bdy. of T.29 S.R. 3 W.
Thence I retrace
West on N. bdy. sec. 3.
- 40.03 1/4 sec. cor., which is a stake greatly decayed, marked as described by the Surveyor General.
Bearing trees have been destroyed.
Set cedar stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S on N. face, and 3 on S. face and dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and W. of cor., and raise mound of earth, 3-1/2 ft. base, 1-1/2 ft. high, S. of cor., from which:
A laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.70*W., 20 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 3 B T.
- 78.32 Cor. secs. 3 and 4, which is a stake, marked as described by the Surveyor General.
Bearing trees have been destroyed.
I destroy markings on this stake referring to secs. 33, and 34, from which:
A laurel, 24 ins. diam., bears S.38*W., 26 lks dist. marked T 29 S R 3 W S 4 B T.
A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S40*E., 53 lks. dist. marked T 29 S R 3 W S 3 B. T.
- 38.41 Thence I retrace
W. on N. bdy. sec. 4.
1/4 sec. cor., which is a stake greatly decayed, marked as described by the Surveyor General.
Bearing trees have been destroyed.
Set fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S on N. and S 4 on S. face, and dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and W. of cor., and raise mound of earth, 3-1/2 ft. base, 1-1/2 ft. high S. of cor., from which:
A maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.80*E., 60 lks dist. marked 1/4 S 4 B T.
No other tree fit to mark.
