	<p>Set fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. secs. 21 and 22, marked C C T 28 S R 3 W on S., S 22 on E., and S 21 on W. faces, from which:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.24*E., 44 lks. dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 22 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.40*W., 14 lks. dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 21 B T.</p> <p>Thence I run</p> <p>South 2' E., on true line bet. secs. 21 and 22, through dense underbrush and heavy timber, descend SW. slope.</p>
17.54	Ravine, bears W., ascend NW. slope.
35.44	<p>Set lava stone, 6 x 10 x 14 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on W. face, from which:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears E. 12 lks dist. marked 1/4 S 22 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.45*W., 36 lks dist. marked 1/4 S 21 B T.</p>
41.54	Top of ridge, bears SW. and NE., descend SW. slope.
51.54	Creek, 3 lks. wide, flows W., ascend N. slope.
52.64	Top of ridge, bears E. and W., descend SW. slope.
67.10	Ravine, bears W., ascend NW. slope.
68.00	Top of ridge, bears NE. and SW., descend S. slope.
75.44	<p>Cor. secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28.</p> <p>Land, mountainous.</p> <p>Soil, rocky, 4th rate.</p> <p>Timber, cedar, fir, hemlock and laurel.</p> <p>Underbrush, rhododendrons, young firs, vine maple and greasewood.</p> <p>Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered, and exceptionally difficult to survey.</p>
