CHAINS	
	Through dense underbrush and heavy timber, ascend SE. slope.
11.00	Top of ridge and trail bears SW. and NE., descend W. slope.
25.10	Creek, 5 lks. wide, flows SW.
26.50	Creek, 3 lks. wide, flows S., ascend E. Slope.
40.00	Set fir post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S 29 on N., and 32 on S. face, from which: A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N.30*W., 9 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 29 B T. An alder, 8 ins. diam., bears S.10*W., 19 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 32 B T.
	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend W. slope.
47.50	Ravine, bears S., ascend E. slope.
58.00	Top of ridge and trail, bears SW. and NE., descend W. slope.
75.80	Creek, 3 lks. wide, flows NW.
80.00	Set fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. secs. 29,30,31 and 32, marked T 28 S S 29 on NE., and R 3 W S 32 on SE., S 31 on SW., and S 30 on NW. face, with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on S. edge, from which: A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.1*E., 9 lks dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 29 B T. A laurel, 5 ins. diam., bears S.36*E., 33 lks. Dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 32 B T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.53*W., 26 lks. dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 31 B T. A maple, 5 ins. diam., bears N.35*W., 29 lks. dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 30 B T.
	Land, mountainous.
	Soil, rocky- 4th rate.
	Timber, cedar, fir, hemlock and laurel.
	Underbrush, rhododendrons, young firs, vine maple and greasewood.
