64.00	Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE., descend NE slope.
73.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows NW., ascend NW. slope.
78.93	Cor. secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.
	Land, mountainous.
	Soil, rocky- 4th rate.
	Timber, cedar, fir, hemlock and maple.
	Underbrush, rhododendrons, vine maple, young firs and greasewood.
	Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered, and exceptionally difficult to survey.
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	From the cor. secs. 28, 29 , 32 and 33,
	I run
	South 3'E. on true line bet. secs. 32 and 33, through dense underbrush and heavy timber, descend S. slope.
14.10	Trail, bears E. and W.
16.20	Creek, 10 lks. wide, flows SW., ascend N. slope.

40.00	Set fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S 32 on W., and 33 on E. face, from which: A maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.32*W., 19 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 32 B T. A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.77*E., 21 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 33 B T.
44.50	Top of ridge, bears E; and W., descend S. slope.
53.50	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows W., ascend N. slope.
72.71	Top of ridge, bears SW. and NE., descend S. slope.
78.94	Intersect S. bdy. of T. 802 lks. W. of N. 1/4 cor. Sec 4. Set cedar stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. secs. 32 and 33, marked
