	<p>with 4 notches on E. and 2 notches on S. face, from which:</p> <p>A maple, 8 ins. diam., bears N.89°E., 26 lks.dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W ^S21 B T.</p> <p>A maple, 6 ins. diam., bears S.17°E., 26 lks.dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 28 B T.</p> <p>A maple, 7 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 20 lks.dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 29 B T.</p> <p>A dogwood, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 18°W., 36 lks.dist. marked T 28 S R 3 W S 20 B T.</p> <p>Land, mountainous.</p> <p>Soil, rocky- 4th rate.</p> <p>Timber, fir, cedar and hemlock.</p> <p>Underbrush, rhododendrons, vine maple and young firs.</p> <p>Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey.</p>
