	Thence I run East on true line bet. secs. 19 and 30. Descend East slope.
5.40	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows S.
9.00	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend E. slope.
21.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows S., ascend S. slope.
27.00	Descend SE. slope
37.00	Creek, 3 lks. wide, flows S., ascend W. slope.
38.91	Set pine stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S 19 on N. and 30 on S. face, from which: A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 18° W., 14 lks dist. marked 1/4 S 30 B T. A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 49° E., 21 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S 19 B T.
50.00	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend E. slope.
55.00	Ravine, bears S., ascend W. slope.
78.91	Cor. secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky- 4th rate. Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock and pine. Underbrush, rhododendrons and young firs. Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey. June 11, 1910.
	Cor. secs. 16 and 17, Thence I run North 1° W., on true line bet. secs. 16 and 17. Descend NW. slope, through dense underbrush and heavy timber.
5.29	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows NW.
6.10	Creek, 6 lks. wide, flows W., ascend S. slope.
9.00	House, Fred Assam, bears E., 12 chs. dist.
23.50	Top of ridge, bears E. and W., descend N. slope.
37.10	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows NW.
