41.10	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows N.
43.00	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend N. slope.
44.00	House, A. Dolan, bears N. 11 chs. dist.
67.75	Buck's Fork, 15 lks. wide, flows S.70*W., ascend S. slope.
78.00	Road, bears S. 80*W. and N. 80*E.
78.10	Creek, 3 lks. wide, flows S.
79.51	Cor. secs. 7,8, 17 and 18. Land mountainous. Soil, rocky- 4th rate. Timber, fir, cedar and hemlock. Underbrush, rhododendrons, young firs, vine maple and greasewood. Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey.
	Thence I run South 89*41'W. on random line bet. secs. 7 and 18.
40.00	Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.
78.50	Intersect N. and S. line, 11 lks. S. of cor. secs. 7, 12,13 and 18 which is a stake marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
	Thence I run North 89*46'E. on true line bet. secs. 7 and 18, through dense underbrush and heavy timber, ascend W.slope.
2.95	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend E. slope.
5.35	Ravine, bears S., ascend SW. slope.
8.01	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend SE. slope.
17.00	Ravine, bears S., ascend SW. slope.
32.00	House, I.P.Gardner, bears S. 20 chs.
35.00	Ridge, bears N. and S., descend E. slope.
