44.00	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., ascend W. slope.
59.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, flows S., ascend W. slope.
63.70	Top of ridge, bears N. and S., descend SE. slope.
72.00	Creek, 4 lks. wide, flows SW., ascend NW. slope.
78.63	Cor. secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.
	Land, mountainous.
	Soil, rocky, 4th rate.
	Timber, cedar, fir, hemlock and matherone.
	Underbrush, rhododendrons, young firs and willows.
	Land mountainous, covered with dense underbrush and heavily timbered and exceptionally difficult to survey.

	North 2'W. on true line bet. secs. 5 and 6, through dense underbrush and heavy timber.

5.40	House, Mrs. Baldwin, bears S.70*W., 2 chs. dist.
9.00	Ascend SW. slope.
40.00	Set fir stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 S 6 on W. and 5 on E. face, from which:

44.56	House, bears W., 10 lks. dist., ascend S. slope.
61.00	House, W. Ball, bears W., 12 chs. dist.
66.00	Top of ridge, bears S.10*E., and N.10*W., ascend E. slope.
78.13	Intersect 17 lks. E. of cor. secs. 31 and 32.
	Set cedar stake, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. secs. 5 and 6, marked C C T
