Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S.64°E., 34 lks. dist. A Y. Oak, 9 ins. diam., bears N.62°E., 30 lks. dist. Land, in valley, first rate prairie, balance, Oak openings. Soil, second and third rate. The valley heads about 15 chs. North.	- 400

24.00	Foot of hill and to a stream 15 lks. wide, SE. and begin to ascend high hill, N. and S. Leave Oak openings and enter brushy Fir timber.	- 150

38.50	A spring branch, 4 lks. wide, Course SE.	
40.00	Set $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. post, from which A double Laurel, 30 ins. diam., bears N.42°E., 80 lks. dist. A Y. Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears S.69°E., 27 lks. dist.	
41.25	Same spring branch, 4 lks. wide, Course NE.	
56.50	Top of ridge, N. and S. Leave brushy timber and enter Oak openings.	+ 1000
64.00	Bottom of ravine, Course SE.	- 450
67.50	Leave Oak openings and enter prairie, NW. and SE.	+ 600
80.00	Set post corner to secs. 34, 35, 2 and 3, from which A Pine, 36 ins. diam., bears N.47 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 181 lks. dist. A Pine, 40 ins. diam., bears S.60°E., 176 lks. dist. Made a mound of rock around post. No other tree being near. Timber, on East slope of steep hill, Fir, Pine, Laurel and Oak. Undergrowth, Hazel, Laurel, Nine Bark, Vine-Maple, Briars, Rose bushes, Currents, Fern, etc. and very thick,	+400
