there is some Fir timber and very brushy. The valley of the South Fork of the Umpqua is generally level and rolling prairie. Soil, 1st and good 2nd rate. Looking Glass Prairie on the creek of the same name extends into the Western side and is 1st rate land. The slopes of the hills afford an excellent range for stock and in many places near 1000 ft. high the soil appeared to be very rich-a black clay-, altogether this is probably one of the best townships in Umpqua valley.
