CHAINS 80.40	Intersect post at cor. Secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16. Post found and witness trees standing.
	West, on true line, between Secs. 9 and 16, Va. 20°30'E.
	Down gradual descent.
27.00	Foot of descent. Level West. Descending South.
35.50	Brook, 6 lks., running South and begin steep ascent.
40.20	Set post 4 ft. long, 4 in. diam., 1 ft. in ground for 1/2 Sec. cor., from which A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.32°E., 10 lks. dist. A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.41 1/2°W., 27 lks. dist.
52.00	Rock bluff, summit of ridge.
61.00	Down side of steep hill, facing South.
77.20	Brook, 6 lks., runs South 2 chs.; thence SE. up steep hill.
80.40	Post set for cor. of Secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17. Land, mountainous and rocky. Soil, third rate. Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock and Yew.
	North, between Secs. 8 and 9. Va. 20°30'E.
15.50	Brook, 4 lks. wide, runs SE.
40.00	Set post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. diam., 1 ft. in ground for 1/2 Sec. cor., from which A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.68°W., 10 lks. dist. A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.70°E., 19 lks. dist.
41.50	Summit of ridge, NW. and SE.
60.00	Brook, 6 lks. wide, runs East.
80.00	On SE. slope of hill, set post 4 ft. long, 5 ins. diam. 1 ft. in ground, for corner of Secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, from which,
