CHAINS

- 1.87 Intersect Hathorn's original $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. on S.bdy. of sec. 33, heretofore described.
Thence
N.89°14'E., on original S. bdy. of sec. 33, through overlap of sec. 4.
- 7.51 Intersect the cor. established by Hathorn for standard $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of sec. 4, now restored as angle point, heretofore described.
Thence S.89°38'E.
- 20.14 Intersect W. bdy. Daniel Huntley D.L.C., 10.28 chs. N.0°05'W. from the SW. cor., hereafter described.
- 32.40 Intersect the original Hathorn cor. of secs. 33 and 34, heretofore described.
N.0°04'W., on original line bet. secs, 33 and 34, through overlap of sec 4.
Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
Descend 144 ft. on NW. slope.
- 1.18 Intersect N. bdy. of original sec. 4, 73 lks. N.88°55'W. from cor. established by Ford for cor. of secs.33 and 34, restored as angle point, hereafter described.
- 2.00 Old timber road, bears NW. and SE.
- 8.10 Looking Glass Creek, 20 lks. wide, course SE.; enter meadow, bears NW. and SE.; ascend 174 ft. on general S. slope, to $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor.
- 18.96 Wire fence, bears E. and W.; enter orchard, same bearing.
- 22.61 Wire fence, bears E. and W.; leave orchard, same bearing.
- 22.85 Looking Glass-Reston road, bears E. and W.
- 23.45 Wire fence, bears E. and W.; enter orchard, same bearing.
- 26.20 Wire fence, bears E. and W.; leave orchard, same bearing; enter timber and brush.
- 29.66 Intersect N. bdy. Daniel Huntley D.L.C., 52.36 chs. N.89°46'W. from the NE. cor., and 12.27 chs. S.89°46'E. from the NW. cor.
