16.50 Dry draw, course SE.; ascend NE. slope, 713 ft. along S. side of draw.

30.90 Top of spur, slopes SE.; continue ascent along S. slope.

36.30 Top of rocky spur, slopes SW.; descend rocky W. slope, 295 ft.

42.40 Apportioned distance.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

64.35 Top of spur, slopes SE.; descend along S. slope, 78 ft.

69.00 Head of draw, course S.; ascend 76 ft.

73.90 Top of spur, slopes SW.; descend 90 ft.

77.40 Head of draw, course SW.; ascend 22 ft.

80.55 Top of spur, slopes SW.; descend NW. slope, 245 ft.
