CHAINS

North, retracing the line bet. secs. 22 and 23; at 40.00 chs. find no trace of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., set temp. cor., and at 79.86 chs. fall 35 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23.

S.89°45'E., retracing the line bet. secs. 14 and 23; at 40.16 chs. no trace of $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., set temp. cor.; at 80.32 chs. no trace of sec. cor., and at 87.14 chs. fall 38 lks. S. of Campbell's cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24.

From the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, I retrace North bet. secs. 13 and 14, and 11 and 12, making diligent and extensive search for Ford cor. at each 40.00 chs. but fail to find any evidence of the cors. County Surveyor Cole has previously made extensive search for these cors. without success and has made a reestablishment of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12, by double proportionate measurement bet. the Ford cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., and the Campbell cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, and bet. the original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11, and original cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

I also retrace Campbell's line bet. secs. 13 and 24, and practically agree with his record bearing and distance.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, on the N.bdy. of the Tp.

S.2°21'W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over mountainous land, through clearing.

Ascend NW. slope, 214 ft. along woven wire fence.

- 8.45 Top of spur, slopes W.; descend SW. slope, 584 ft.
- 17.15 Wire fence, bears NW. and SE.
- 29.95 Woven wire fence, bears E. and W.
- 34.45 S.R.Brisbin's house on line.
- 35.55 Road, bears E. and W.
- 40.30 Draw, course W.; ascend NW. slope, 131 ft.
- 41.25 Leave clearing; enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.
- 46.92 Intersect local $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, which is an oak post, 4 ins. sq., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face; from which

A black oak, 10 ins. diam., bears S.8°W., 4 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.

Note: I adopt this cor., which is represented as being in approximate position of the old cor. and appears to be set at intersection of the line of Ford's blazes and the prolongation of the S. bdy. of the McCullough Donation Land Claim, which is on the theoretical center latitudinal subdivision line of sec. 6. I do not alter or disturb this cor. in any way.

Thence from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
