- 31.30 Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE.; descend W. slope, 268 ft.
- 40.95 Draw, course N.; trail, bears N. and S. 20° E.; ascend SE. slope, 150 ft.
- 43.47 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp., at the resurvey cor. of secs. 30 and 31.
- Original Ford cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, bears N. 69° 57' W., 4.12 chs. dist.
- Land, rolling.
- Soil, clay loam, 2nd rate.
- Timber, fir, oak, laurel, and cedar.
- Undergrowth, hazel, fir, laurel, and oak.

- 27.55 Top of spur, slopes SE.; descend 54 ft.
- 34.30 Proportionate distance.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
