- S.78*56'E., bet. Tracts Nos. 49 and 50, along the center latitudinal subdivision line of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 18.
- 2.82 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 8 W., 6.29 chs. N.0*23'E. from the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, hereafter described.
- 25.59 Point for NW. 1/16 sec. cor. of original sec. 18.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. No. 4 of this survey, identical with cor. No. 1 of Tract No. 50, with brass cap marked
