

Metes and Bounds Survey of Tract No. 54,
T. 29 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for cor. No. 3 of this survey, with brass cap marked

:TR 54
:AP 3

from which

A laurel, 16 ins. diam., bears N.57°E., 98 lks. dist., marked A P 3 TR 54 B T.

Thence

S.80°06'E., along the S. bdy. of Tract No. 54, on the center latitudinal subdivision line of original sec.30.

2.90 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 8 W., at the re-survey $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 30 only, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., hereafter described.

23.78 Point for W. 1/16 sec. cor. of original sec. 30

N.0°52'E., along the E. bdy. of Tract No. 54, along the west meridional subdivision line of original sec. 30.

19.17 Intersect cor. No. 1 of this survey, identical with Cor. No. 4 of Tract No. 53, and place of beginning.
