

East Bdy. T. 29 S., R. 7 W.

(Hathorn Survey)

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for resurvey $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 18 only, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., with brass cap marked

$\frac{1}{4}$ S18
1924

from which

A black oak, 30 ins. diam., bears N.52*E., 29 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.

A pine, 60 ins. diam., bears S.31*E., 64 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.

19.00 Enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.

32.64 Intersect the line bet. Tracts Nos. 51 and 52, S.78*26'E., 2.86 chs. from the S. $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of the W. bdy. of original sec. 18, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., heretofore described.

39.73 Intersect the Hathorn $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, located by measurement from the original bearing trees. The marks are grown over, but the blazes are plain.

At the exact cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 13 only, with brass cap marked

from which (the original bearing trees)

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.45*E., 28 lks. dist., (not N.44*E.)

A black oak, 14 ins. diam., bears N.52*W., 30 lks. dist. (not N.54*W.)

New bearing trees:

A fir, 16 ins, diam., bears S.52*W., 19 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.87*W., 41 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

Continue descent, 73 ft.

43.55 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.

46.15 Trail, bears NW. and SE.
