A laurel, rotted down, bears S.67*W., 50 lks. dist.,

stump shows position.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.89*W., 139 lks. dist.

(not N.85*W.), marks are plain on the bark.

No evidence of NE. bearing tree.

New bearing trees:

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.33*E., 49 lks. dist.,

marked T 29 S R 8 W S 24 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 54 lks. dist.,

marked T 29 S R 8 W S 25 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.35*W., 32 lks. dist.,

marked T 29 S R 8 W S 26 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.65*W., 51 lks. dist.,

marked T 29 S R 8 W S 23 B T.

Land, rolling.

Soil, rocky clay loam, 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock, and laurel.

Undergrowth, fair, hazel, laurel, and hemlock.

S.89*57'E., bet. secs. 24 and 25.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense under-
 growth.

Descend over SE. slope, 122 ft.

3.75 Head of draw, course S.

6.05 Head of draw, course S.; ascend SW. slope, 175 ft.

13.40 Top of spur, slopes S.; descend SE. slope, 45 ft.

16.35 Head of draw, course S.; ascend W. slope, 147 ft.

23.45 Top of spur, slopes SW.; descend along S. slope 32 ft.

26.40 Head of draw, course SW.; ascend SW. slope, 175 ft.

34.80 Top of ridge, bears NW. and S.20*E.; descend over SE.
