

Subdivisions, T. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, on the S. bdy.
of the Tp.

North, bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over rolling land, through heavy timber and dense under-
growth.

Along W. slope.

6.00 Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend NE. slope, 106 ft.

10.30 Draw, course NW.; ascend along W. slope, 5 ft.

11.70 Point of spur, slopes NW.; descend NW. slope, 110 ft.

20.05 Draw, water in pools, course SW.; ascend SE. slope.

21.70 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 29 S., R. 7 W., 9.01 chs.

N.89*40'E. from the cor. of secs. 33 and 34.

At the point of intersection

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in
the ground, for cor. of secs. 33 and 34, with brass
cap marked

A live oak, 16 ins. diam., bears S.50*E., 55 lks.
dist., marked T 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ S R 7 W S 34 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.71*W., 91 lks. dist.,
marked T 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ S R 7 W S 33 B T.

Land, rolling.

Soil, clay loam, 2nd rate.

Timber, fir, oak, laurel, cedar, and pine.

Undergrowth, hazel, laurel, and fir.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, on the S. bdy.
of the TP.

North, bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Over mountainous land, through open pine timber.

Ascend SW. slope, 83 ft.

9.00 Leave pine opening, bears NE. and SW.; enter heavy
timber and dense undergrowth.

11.00 Top of spur, slopes SW.; descend NW. slope, 400 ft.
