

General Description

CHAINS

24 chains, is all wild land covered with brush and timber. There are no improvements.

T. 28 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ W.

This fractional township is a hiatus between Hathorn's east boundary of T. 28 S., R. 8 W. and Ford's west boundary of T. 28 S., R. 7 W. It is a strip of land about 6 chs. wide at the northern end and a little over 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles long, running to a point at the southern end.

The only improved portion is the fragmentary south half of Section 30, situated in Ten Mile Valley. The remainder is hilly and covered with brush and timber.

T. 28 S., R. 8 W.

All, except the southern portion of the east boundary of this township, extends across unimproved wild land. The east boundary of Sections 25 and 36 is partly situated in the Ten Mile Valley, which is long settled and improved land.

A portion of the John Coats Donation Land Claim is situated in Sections 25 and 36, and the Lathrop Claim is also located in these sections.

T. 29 S., R. 8 W.

The east boundary of this township, except in Section 1, extends across unimproved hilly land. The greater portion of the Waters Donation Land Claim is situated in Section 1 and south of this claim there are no improvements adjacent to this line.
