T.A sugar pine, 40 ins. diam., bears N.61*W., 74 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 B. T.

40.25 Ridge point.

80.00 Set a basalt stone, 15x10x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, marked with 5 notches on N. and 1 notch on S. edge., from which

A red fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.80*E., 70 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 30 B. T.

A red fir 12 ins. diam., bears S.66*E., 56 lks. dist., marked T.29 S R 1 W S 31 B. T.

A red fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.8*W., 59 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 36 B. T.

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.17*W., 55 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 25 B. T.

Land, mountainous.
