- 5.38 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.
- 11.78 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W.
- 17.10 Creek, 2 lks. wide course W.
- 40.00 Set a basalt stone, 20x6x6 ins., 15 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face., from which
  - A sugar pine, 10 ins. diam., N.45\*E., 30 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 30 B. T.
  - A red fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.21\*W., 46 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 25 B. T.
- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 16x12x8 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, marked with 4 notches on N. and 2 notches on S. edge., from which
  - A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.39\*E., 73 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 19 B. T.
  - A red fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S51\*E., 23 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 30 B. T.
  - A red fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.89\*W., 85 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 25 B. T.
  - A yellow pine, 36 ins. diam., bears N.74\*W., 50 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 24 B. T.

Land, mountainous.

Timber, red fir, sugar and yellow pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, arrowwood, chinquapin and willow.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
