	Land, mountainous. Soil, loam and stoney, 2nd. and 3rd. rate. Timber, red and white fir, sugar pine, cedar and hemlock. Undergrowth, chinquapin, vine maple and snow brush. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chs.
	South 89*52'E. on a random line bet. secs. 9 and 16.
40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.02	Intersect N. and S. line, 12 lks. N. of cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16. Thence I run North 89*47'W. on a true line bet. secs. 9 and 16. Over mountainous land through scattering timber and dense undergrowth. Asc. NE. slope.
17.04	Creek, 1 1/2 lks. wide, course NE.
26.50	Summit of ridge, bears NE. and SW. Desc. NW. slope.
30.40	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE. Asc. E. Slope.
32.89	Spring.
40.01	Set a basalt stone, 12x10x6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A red fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.69*E., 137 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T. A dogwood, 7 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 57 lks, dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T.
47.00	Summit of ridge, bears NE. and SW. Desc. NW. slope.
48.00	Enter heavy timber, bears NE. and SW.
55.25	Gulch, course NE.
