79.96	The cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30. Land, mountainous. Soil, loam and stoney, 2nd. and 3rd. rate. Timber, red and white fir, sugar pine, cedar. Undergrowth, chinquapin, snow brush, hazel and arrowwood. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 79.96 chs.
40.00	South 89°45'W. on a random line bet. secs. 19 and 30. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
