

## Subdivisions of T. 29 S., R. 1 W.,

## CHAINS

- At the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30.  
 Thence I run  
 North 0°4'W., bet. secs. 19 and 20.  
 Over mountainous land through dense undergrowth.  
 Asc. gradually along SE. slope.
- .60 Settlers' trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 12.78 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.
- 40.00 Set a porphyry stone, 18x12x6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground  
 for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, from which  
 A red fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.56°E., 113 lks.  
 dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 20 B. T.  
 A laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.72°W., 82 lks. dist.,  
 marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 19 B T.
- 47.25 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.
- 54.50 Enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.
- 56.70 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE.
- 69.00 Summit of ridge bears NW. and SE.  
 Desc. NE. slope.
- 73.60 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course SE.  
 Asc. SE. slope.
- 80.00 Set a basalt stone, 16x10x5 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for  
 cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, marked with 3 notches  
 on S. and 5 notches on E. edge, from which  
 A red fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.46°E., 90 lks.  
 dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 17 B T.  
 A red fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.12°E., 37 lks.  
 dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 20 B T.  
 A red fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.50°W., 82 lks.  
 dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 19 B T.  
 A red fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.43°W., 26 lks.  
 dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 18 B T.
- Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, loam and stony, 2nd and 3rd rate.
