CHAINS	
	Asc. from cor. through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
19.00	Enter old burn, bears NE. and SW.
30.00	Top of ascent, bears N. and S. about 300 ft. above sec. cor. Thence over level bench.
39.50	Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on the N. Bdy. of sec. 3 T. 30 S. R. 1 W. heretofore described.
40.00	Set a basalt stone, 16x12x10 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. common to 2 quarters of sec. 34 only, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.40 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 133 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T. A pine, 30 ins. diam., bears N.51 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 120 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T. Note- This pine is the bearing tree formerly marked as accessory to the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
54.00	Leave old burn, bears N. and S. Enter heavy timber.
78.00	Asc. 50 ft.
80.00	Set a basalt stone, 24x8x8 ins. 18 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 34 and 35, marked with 2 notches on E., and 4 notches on W. edge, from which A white fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N.58*E., 19 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 35 B T. A red fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N.59 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 86 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 1 W S 34 B T. Land, mountainous, rolling and level. Soil, clay loam and stony, 2nd. and 4rd. rate, Timber, fir, cedar, pine and hemlock. Undergrowth, maple, laurel, dogwood, small fir and hemlock.
	N.89*53'E. on S. Bdy. of sec. 35. Asc. through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
3.03	Intersect the cor. of secs. 2, and 3, T. 30 S., R. 1 W. heretofore described.
