CHAINS

S.89*51'E., retracing the line bet. secs. 8 and 17, at 40.29 chs. fall 66 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 80.53 chs. fall 55 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17.

S.89*47'E., retracing the line bet. secs. 9 and 16., at 40.63 chs. fall 7 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and, at 80.37 chs. fall 9 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.

East, retracing the line bet. secs. 10 and 15; at 36.16 chs. intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and, at 76.20 chs. intersect the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15.

S.89*50'E., retracing the line bet. secs. 11 and 14; at 39.53 chs. intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and, at 78.87 chs. intersect the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.

N.89*58'E., retracing the line bet. secs. 12 and 13; at 40.24 chs. intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and, at 115.03 chs. intersect the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 29S., R. 1W.

From the cor. of secs. 7 and 18 on the W. Bdy. of the Tp., which is a porphyry stone, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general.

N.89*45'E., along the N. Bdy. of sec. 18.
