From this cor. the old cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 S., Rs. 1
and 2 W., which is a basalt stone, firmly set, marked
and witnessed as described by the surveyor general, bears
N.35*31'E., 55.16 chs. dist. I now change this cor. to
refer to T. 28 S., R. 1 W. only and obliterate all
markings on the old SE., SW. and NW. bearing trees.

bdy. of sec. 35; at 39.98 chs. fall 18 lks. N. of the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 80.04 chs. fall 5 lks. S. of the
cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, West retracing S.
bdy. of sec. 34; at 40.11 chs. fall 7 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor., and at 80.10 chs. fall 24 lks. N. of the cor.
of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, West retracing S.
bdy. of sec. 33; at 39.77 chs. fall 8 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor., and at 79.46 chs. fall 25 lks. N. of the cor.
of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, West retracing S.
bdy. of sec. 32; at 39.83 chs. fall 6 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor., and at 79.83 chs. fall 14 lks. N. of the cor.
of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, West retracing S.
bdy. of sec. 31; at 39.80 chs. fall 11 lks. N. of the
 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 85.99 chs. fall 23 lks. N. of the
closing cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 S., R. 2 W.
